# VISITING RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS 2010-2011

Applications are invited for the **Imam Bukhari** and **Imam Tirmizi** Visiting Research Fellowships tenable during the academic year 2010-2011.

Applicants should be citizens of countries in Asia or Africa. Preference will be given to those studying classical Islamic sciences, although other areas in the humanities and social sciences will be considered. Each Research Fellowship carries a stipend of £3000 and membership of the Common Room. The stipend is intended as a supplementary award and may be held in conjunction with other research grants, stipends, or sabbatical salaries. The Visiting Research Fellowships may be held from 1 October 2010 for a minimum period of three months.

These Visiting Research Fellowships are intended to encourage interaction among academics from different traditions of learning. The Imam Bukhari and Imam Tirmizi Fellows will be expected to devote their time to research and writing and to participate in the Centre's academic activities.

## **Application Procedure:**

Further details and application forms may be obtained from the Academic Assistant or from the Centre website. Applications should include a *curriculum vitae* and a brief statement of proposed research. Two letters of recommendation should be sent directly to the Centre.
