The Oxford Centre for Islamic Studies (OCIS) is offering scholarships to five British Muslim students undertaking undergraduate study at the University of Oxford in any field other than medicine. The awards cover University and College fees and a means-tested maintenance allowance. Awards may be made in conjunction with other sources of funding, although other funding will be taken into account when determining the value of the OCIS award.

Scholarship Summary

The purpose of the Scholarships is to encourage and assist students to undertake studies that will be of benefit to the Muslim world. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of financial need and academic merit. Applicants must have applied to UCAS and Oxford, as described on the Undergraduate Admissions webpage, by 15 October 2009.

What is funded?

The Scholarship offers fees and maintenance support and should ensure students do not need to take out government loans in order to undertake their studies. Up to five awards will be available.

The closing date for applications for OCIS Scholarships for students wishing to start in October 2010 is 26 February 2010.
