The Oxford Centre for Islamic Studies (OCIS) is offering up to five scholarships to British Muslim students undertaking undergraduate study at the University of Oxford in any field other than medicine. The awards cover University and College fees and a maintenance grant. Awards may be made in conjunction with other sources of funding, although other funding will be taken into account when determining the value of the OCIS award.

Purpose of Scholarships

The purpose of the Scholarships is to widen access to higher education and to encourage and assist students to undertake studies that will be of benefit to the Muslim world. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic merit and financial need. Applicants must have applied to UCAS and the University of Oxford, as described on its Undergraduate Admissions website.



Closing Date

The deadline for OCIS Scholarships applications for students wishing to start in October 2012 will be in February 2012 (check website below for updates).
