

SCHOLAR-IN-RESIDENCE PROGRAMME

The Oxford Centre for Islamic Studies promotes excellence in the study of Islam and Muslim societies. Applications are invited for Scholar-in-Residence positions tenable at the Centre for the academic year commencing October 2022.

Scholar-in-Residence awards are primarily intended for academics who wish to spend up to a year at the Centre. Applicants should normally have obtained a doctorate or equivalent degree by the time they join the Centre. Well-established academics who wish to spend sabbatical time at the Centre are welcome to apply. The research to be undertaken during residency should be in an area relevant to the study of Islam or the Muslim world.

Each Scholar-in-Residence will be provided with office space, access to library facilities, membership of the Common Room and meals at the Common Table. The Centre will assist Scholars-in-Residence in finding residential accommodation.

Scholars-in-Residence are self-funded and pay a fee of £1,500 per term towards the cost of their stay at the Centre.
