The Oxford Centre for Islamic Studies promotes excellence in the study of Islam and Muslim societies. Applications are invited for non-stipendiary Visiting Fellowships and Visiting Research Fellowships tenable at the Centre for the academic year commencing October 2026.

Non-stipendiary Visiting Fellowships and Visiting Research Fellowships are primarily intended for scholars who wish to spend up to one academic year (October to June) at the Centre. Applicants should normally be at post-doctoral or equivalent level by the time they join the Centre. Well-established academics who wish to spend their sabbatical leave at the Centre are welcome to apply. The research undertaken during residence should be in an area relevant to the study of Islam or the Muslim world.

Visiting Fellows and Visiting Research Fellows are members of the Common Room and are provided with desk space, access to library facilities, and meals at the Common Table when served. They will be self-funded and a hosting fee of £1,500 per Term may be charged towards the cost of their stay at the Centre. The Centre can advise on renting residential accommodation.
