



VISITING RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS

2026 - 2027

The Oxford Centre for Islamic Studies promotes excellence in the study of Islam and Muslim societies. Applications are invited for Visiting Research Fellowships tenable at the Centre for the academic year commencing October 2026.

Two Visiting Research Fellowships are offered and are intended to encourage interaction among academics from different traditions of learning. Preference will be given to those studying classical Islamic sciences, although other areas in the humanities and social sciences will also be considered. Citizens of countries found in Asia and Africa are particularly encouraged to apply for this scheme.

Applicants should normally be at the postdoctoral level or equivalent.

The Visiting Research Fellowship carries a stipend of £4000, intended as a supplementary award, which may be held in conjunction with other research grants, stipends, or sabbatical salaries. Visiting Research Fellows will be provided with working space, membership of the Common Room including use of the Centre's dining facilities, and assistance with finding residential accommodation.
